***** Things to bring/ Info and Requirements *****

**(Meet us at the picnic tables behind the parking lot and in front of the barn
at 9:30am for registration on the first day)**

TO BRING CHECKLIST

- Release of Liability Form**—Child will not be able to participate in mounted activities until this form has been signed by a parent/guardian. (See Page 4 for Release Form)
- Completed Registration Form with Parent's Emergency phone Numbers and allergies Listed**
- POOL PERMISSION SLIP** (can be filled out the day of camp)
- Final camp payment due the first day of child's camp week**
- Riding Boots OR Boots with a ½ inch to 1 inch heel**—(snow boots, rain boots, or work boots are dangerous and are not acceptable!)
- Approved Riding Helmet** – for sanitary purposes it is highly recommended that your child have his/her own helmet. however, we will provide riding school helmets free of charge if your child does not have one. Helmets can be purchased at any local tack shop, or here at the farm for \$45. We carry all sizes and colors.
- Riding Britches, Jodhpurs, OR lightweight ¾ length pants or leggings**—*(no shorts for riding! Ouch!)*
- Extra Clothes: shorts/ T-Shirt**—Labeled with your child's name
- Big old T-shirt or Art Smock if you wish to protect their clothing during arts and crafts**
- Bathing Suit, Towel, and flip flops for the pool**—Labeled with your child's Name. Please have your child come to camp with his or her bathing suit on under their clothes, for our quick change and dash to the pool! If this is not possible, we do have a changing room.
- Lunch, snacks, and several drinks**—labeled with your child's name. We have a refrigerator where lunches will be kept if needed. Sports bottle filled with ice—labeled with your child's name. We have coolers of cold water available at all times. Cold bottled water is available for purchase for \$1.00.
- If your child is on any medications, or has allergy medications that need to be kept with him or her, these meds must be labeled clearly with child's name and directions. They must be given directly to Maria Mendonca, who is a licensed Physician Assistant. Parents will be required to sign a permission form for their use.**
- Sun block**—already applied.
- Bug Spray**—We will apply here if necessary.
- Tennis Racquet** —if your child has one and would like to participate in free play tennis (not required).

We provide popsicles to all the children every day. If you do not want your child to have one please let us know!

**Please remember that pick up is at 3:30 sharp. If you need additional childcare, before
and after care is available but must be reserved in advance.**
