Welcome to Painted Dreams Horse Farm

We are proud to continue the Brownie/Girl Scout and Cub Scout/Boy Scout Program at our facility. We have been honored to be part of the scouting experience since 2005. Our facility prides itself on safety, horsemanship, teaching responsibility, and building self esteem.

Our program lasts approximately 2 hours. Scouts are split up into 3 groups: Hands on Practical, Presentation, and Riding. The groups then rotate so that all of the scouts have an opportunity to participate in each group.

Scouts have an opportunity to learn horsemanship skills—including safety, approaching, and leading, haltering, grooming, hoof care. They also learn about saddles, saddle pads, bridles, and bits—and how to tack up the ponies or horses correctly.

Your group will also have a choice of an equine related presentation or a horse craft (for those younger troops!!) Examples of our equine presentations include: nutrition, horse illnesses and basic veterinary care, breeds and colors, disciplines of riding, or “what you need to know to keep your horse at home”.

Each Scout will also have an opportunity to participate in a one on a private, or a semiprivate or group, mounted lesson with one of our trainers (private verses semiprivate are based on the ages and experience levels of the scouts).

Our program successfully fulfills all the requirements for most badges. Boy Scout Merit Badges are discussed on an individual basis.

Fees:

Our discounted programs are open to all scout troops only. We offer two types of programs to suite all size troops.

- 1) Per student fee: \$25 per scout with an 9 scout minimum
- OR
- 2) Per program fee: \$300 for troops with up to 18 scouts
